targeted case management

DCCH Center for Children & Families will use their \$10,000 grant award to support their Target Case Management services program, which will increase access to care across the spectrum of providers for Northern Kentucky children on Medicaid. The goal of this program is to provide care coordination and early intervention to avoid admission to, as well as support after discharge from, an out-of-home placement like a group home or foster care.



ready to code

Kenton County Public Library will use their \$14,700 grant for their Ready to Code program, which engages students who are underrepresented in computing careers including students of color, girls/young women and those economically disadvantaged. Its purpose is to increase the number of students in Kenton County receiving computer science instruction and to increase equity in representation in computing in our region.



project HOPE (housing opportunities for people everywhere)

Legal Aid of the Bluegrass will use their \$15,000 grant to support Project HOPE (Housing Opportunities for People Everywhere). Project HOPE will lead to the creation of self-help documentation and an online screening tool for housing-related legal issues, giving people access to a 24/7 database of information that will directly resolve many housing issues.



hope for hispanic health

Rose Garden Center for Hope and Healing will use their \$9,500 grant for their Hope for Hispanic Health program. The purpose of this program is to build wellness among the Latino/Hispanic population in Northern Kentucky to support cultural assimilation and economic integration. Services include in-house hepatitis C and diabetes testing, women's wellness and pregnancy services, tobacco cessation, a clinical psychologist, and more.
